Instructions for Resignation of Minister

Resignation may be for any reason.

Notification to the assigning minister should be timely and public.

Reasons should be given to dispel confusion and misrepresentation.

A Termination of Minister, Form A 5:5, should be made out and distributed with reference to the resignation of the minister.

Copies of this Form R14:13 may be made available upon request.

It is always advised to do every thing before witnesses.

Preselected numbered alternate trustees should be notified and assigned. If there are no alternates available a new Minister/trustee must be selected by the congregation in consensus. In any case all elders and electors of the congregation should be notified as soon as possible.

In essence termination is only the power to terminate the original appointment or assignment. There is no power to elect a new replacement to any office that is terminated by resignation or otherwise.

Guidelines for His Church Auxiliaries

Sec. 19. The Minister may tend his resignation for any reason , preferably with notice to other Minister of His Church and the Protectors. [see form R 14:13]

Sec. 20. If a particular auxiliary Church and accounts can no longer be maintained nor needs to be maintained, then the trust is to be dissolved and the corpus of that trust is to be distributed among other Ministries of His Church and the their congregations.

Ministrative Guidelines for His Church

Sec. 8 Par. (9) Resignation of Minister should be with notice to Electors in congregation and the Protector, [CG 18.]

(a) a new Minister should be elected and appointed in accordance with the Church Guidelines and the Polity of His Holy Church,

Sec. 9 Par. (3) Termination of church may be necessary [CG 20.]

(a) when no Minister can be found to take the place of a terminated or resigned Minister, and

(b) electors in congregation no longer can be found.
