Instructions for the Marriage License and Certificate

This **Marriage License and Certificate** model is an official form of His Church and is offered in good faith and service to all those who wish to engage in the Rites of Holy Matrimony as instituted by our Father and Creator in Heaven.

The first part of this form should be filled out by those intending to marry and by fixing their signatures to this document they express their intent to be married in a Frank marriage in accordance to the Rites of Holy Matrimony.

The second part of this form is to be filled out by *concerned* parties of this Union including but not limited to the surviving parents, guardian or other family members.

By this *license* the Bridegroom and Bride are hereby granted permission to enter into the bonds of Marriage and the Rites of Matrimony as Husband and Wife to be Solemnized before Witnesses and certified by a Minister of the Gospel according to the consent of the parties and under the authority of Canon Law, the Will of God.

The third part of this form is the **Marriage Certification** for Official use only. This form may be used to bear witness to their Union by the Authority of His Holy Church and its auxiliary Churches. It includes spaces for location, time and witnesses to the ceremonial exchange of vows.

The signatures of two witnesses to the ceremony are required for the completion of this form.

A minister in attendance must sign as witness for the Church to this binding agreement to marry between two consenting adults of the opposite sex as Husband and Wife under the authority of God the Father and further to the testimony of witnesses of this ritual and ceremony.

Upon receipt of this certificate the Church shall seal the document as a witness before God and Man of the Free and Sacred Union of the participating parties under the Rites of Holy Matrimony.

Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Matthew 19:6.

This License and Certificate and *true and actual copies* under the seal of the Church shall be kept on file by The Church and by the married couple. They shall be used and received as an official witness to all the world of the Solemnization of their Union.

Primary Remedy for this contract is by binding arbitration before the Church in accordance with the dictates of Jesus Christ to His appointed Ministers, the polity of the Church and Cannon Law.

Biblical references on Matrimony
