The Groom then signs and dates his part of the contract with the printed name of the Bride.

The Bride then signs and dates her part of the contract with the printed name of the Groom.

The Witnesses then sign and date.

The minister of the Church does then sign and date.

The document or documents should then be sealed by the Church and Copies made and certified and distributed.
